



F.D. ROOSEVELT HIGH SCHOOL ATHLETIC HALL OF FAME

The F.D. Roosevelt High School Athletic Hall of Fame is a means to recognize athletes, coaches, and community members and businesses for their accomplishment, contribution and dedication to athletics.

The nomination criteria are noted below. The Induction to the Hall of Fame will take place in conjunction with our Senior Athlete Awards Night each Spring.

1. Organization
 - A. The Hall of Fame committee shall be made up of the following:
 - a. Three current coaches (male and female)
 - b. Two community members (male and female)
 - c. Two At Large
 - B. Facilitator – Cannot vote
2. Nomination Process
 - A. Anyone can submit nominations or applications to the F.D. Roosevelt High School Athletic Office
 - B. Download the nomination form from the HPCSD Website or in the F.D. Roosevelt High School Athletic Office
 - C. Nomination forms and specified supporting materials must be submitted to the F.D. Roosevelt High School Athletic Office
3. Eligibility and Criteria
 - A. Categories
 - a. Athlete – eligible for consideration after 5 years graduation from FDR
 - b. Coach – must have been a coach in the Hyde Park Central School District
 - c. Honorary – someone who has made a significant impact on FDR athletics or sectional, state, national, international, or professional levels
 - d. Team – eligible for consideration after 5 years
 - B. Maximum number of inductees each year
 - Athlete - 3
 - Coach – 1
 - Honorary – 1
 - Team – 1
 - C. One inductee may be posthumous – a committee decision
 - D. Applications must include:
 - a. Current resume (must include FDR High School and post high school achievements and all recognition and honors)
 - b. Supporting materials (newspaper articles, letters of recommendation)
 - c. Other supporting materials
4. Screening and Voting of Nominees
 - A. Applications shall be screened by committee before a vote
 - B. Five (5) committee members must be present for a vote
