


Check off	<h2 style="text-align: center;">Third Grade Supply List</h2> 
1	8 1/2" x 11" 5 subject spiral notebook *Single subject notebooks <b>do not</b> provide enough paper for all writing units.*
5	Very <u> durable </u> folders Non-tearing plastic preferred with pockets on the <b>bottom</b> , not on the sides.
1	Pencil/Supply Pouch - Large enough to fit <b>all</b> supplies *No hard cases please!*
3	Packs of regular #2 <b>Ticonderoga</b> pencils/10 or 12 to a pack (Please sharpen at home!) Please no mechanical pencils or personal pencil sharpeners, they become too much of a distraction!
1	Large eraser
1	Package of colored pencils
1	Package of crayons
1	Scissors ( <b>Child-sized</b> , please!)
4	Packs of <u>yellow</u> sticky notes
3-4	Boxes of tissues
1	Pack of 2 highlighters
2	Small <b>Elmer's</b> glue sticks
2	Non-odor dry erase markers No yellow please, it writes too lightly to be seen.

In addition, children should plan to have these items:

- A backpack everyday. Large enough to fit folders and notebooks.
- A healthy snack everyday. They should bring 1 drink and 1 item to eat for snack.
- A lunch from home or lunch money everyday. If your child is purchasing lunch it can be purchased through the cafeteria or online. If you need to send in any money it is best kept in a sealed envelope labeled with your child's first and last name. The envelope should be placed in your child's home/school folder. Menus will be sent home during the first week of school and can also be viewed online.
- Sneakers on PE days
- Library books on Library days

We hope this list is helpful for your planning. We have tried to cover all materials needed for the school year, but additional materials may be needed as the year progresses. **Please label personal belongings such as lunch boxes, backpacks, and clothing.** This ensures that any misplaced items are returned to their owner!
