School Tax Rate Factors

- ▶ Tax Levy- The amount that the school district needs to collect in taxes for each school year. The tax levy is determined by subtracting all known revenues, including fund balance appropriations from the total budget.
- ▶ Total Taxable Assessed Value- Based on market value and determined by each individual municipality.
- ▶ Equalization Rate (EQ Rate) The state's measure of a municipality's level of assessment as determined by the NYS Office of Real Property Tax Service (NYSORPTS).
